Scrappy Serger Quilt by Sandra Geiger

Scrappy Serger Quilt Instructions

Cut all blocks, borders, backing and backing according to the cutting guide.
Arrange and label all cut pieces by color and size.

Quilt Top Rows

Starting at the top of each row, label the first fabric in each row with a row number label.

Row 1; start with a $10\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", piece of fabric #1 and end with $10\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric #5.

Row 2; start with a $5\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", piece of fabric #4 and end with $5\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric #4.

Row 3; start with a $10\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", piece of fabric #3 and end with $10\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric #2.

Row 4; start with a $5\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", piece of fabric #1 and end with $5\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric #1.

Row 5; start with a $10\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", piece of fabric #5 and end with $10\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric #4.

Row 6; start with a $5\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", piece of fabric #3 and end with $5\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric #3.

Press all seams toward the darker fabric.

Stack quilt top rows in order from 1 to 6, with row one on top.

Layer backing and batting, with wrong side of backing strips facing batting strips, aligning all cut edges. (In the desired order if they are color blocking the quilt back.)

Quilt assembly

1. First layer; from bottom to top
 - A. Batting
 - B. Row 2 backing with right side up
 - C. Row 1 backing with wrong side up
 - D. Batting
 - E. Row 1 top with right side up
 - F. Row 2 top with wrong side up

Note;
Align all layers at the top of quilt
The batting and backing will be longer than the quilt top row, this will be trimmed later.
2. Stitch along the right edge, from the top to bottom using a $\frac{1}{4}$ ", seam allowance.
3. Pull the backing, batting and top of row 2 to the right, lay flat and press the seam toward the right. Be careful not to press on the label.
4. Add extra quilting to rows 1 and 2 at this time if desired and each layer as it is added
5. Second layer
 - a. Batting
 - b. Row 3 backing with right side up
 - c. Cut edges of row 2 quilt sandwich
 - d. Row 3 top with wrong side up



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6. Repeat steps 2 thru 4 above after adding each layer.
7. Third layer
 - a. Batting
 - b. Row 4 backing with right side up
 - c. Cut edges of row 3 quilt sandwich
 - d. Row 4 top with wrong side up
8. Fourth layer
 - a. Batting
 - b. Row 5 backing with right side up
 - c. Cut edges of row 4 quilt sandwich
 - d. Row 5 top with wrong side up
9. Fifth layer
 - a. Batting
 - b. Row 6 backing with right side up
 - c. Cut edges of row 5 quilt sandwich
 - d. Row 6 top with wrong side up

Borders

10. Trim top and bottom edges of quilt with a rotary cutter and ruler.
11. Border layering
 - a. Batting
 - b. Border backing
 - c. Cut edges of quilt sandwich
 - d. Border
12. Side Borders
 - a. Layer
 - b. Stitch
 - c. Press seams
13. Top and Bottom Borders
 - a. Layer
 - b. Stitch
 - c. Press seams

Finish with Serger Quilt Binding
